NEW GRADE REPLACEMENT PROCESS

QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE



Reminder: Undergraduate students are still limited up to two (2) courses (maximum of 8 hours) for grade replacement.

WHAT IS CHANGING?

Beginning Fall 2021, undergraduate students will have eligible repeated courses automatically selected for grade replacement. Students can either cancel or change the course which is selected until the withdrawal deadline.

HOW DO YOU GET THERE?

Log in to my.uncc.edu and click the Banner Self Service icon under quick links. Click on the Student Services/Student Accounts tab > Student Records > **Grade Replacement - Starting Fall 2021**

STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS (See Example on pg. 2)

- 1. Review the information displayed.
- 2. Click on either the "Cancel" or "Request" buttons next to the course(s).
- Check a box to confirm selection

 (a lecture-lab combination requires an additional confirmation for the lab).
- 4. Click the Submit button.
- Status will update to "Pending Processing" (or "Pending Review" for topics courses) until a final grade is received.
- Students can modify their selection at any time before the deadline by following the same steps.

AUTOMATIC SELECTION CRITERIA:

Grade Replacement will automatically be applied for the first two courses repeated where the previous grade earned was a C or below including the additional criteria below:

- Earliest registration, then
- Highest credit hours, then
- Lowest prior grades, then
- Alpha by subject, then
- Highest course number

Note: If a student repeats a course with a lab, the lecture-lab combination counts as one grade replacement.

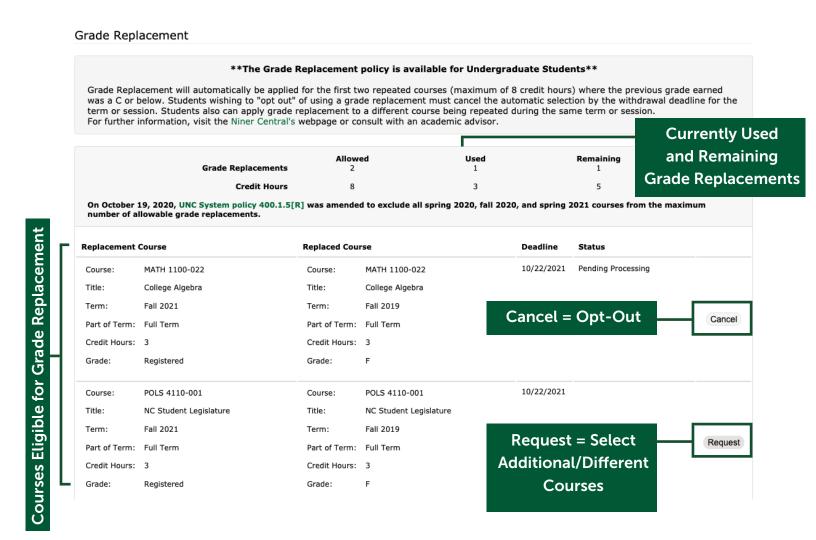
Topics courses must have the same title as the original topics course to be eligible for grade replacement.
